The school community refined its school purpose statement, a vision statement and the values and actions which would underpin the achievement of the following vision: At YEC, we provide positive, empowering learning experiences that respond to the needs of every student, and maximise their life opportunities in and beyond their schooling education.

Site Information

Youth Education Centre is a public education site situated in the greater metropolitan area of Adelaide.

The core values of the Youth Education Centre are:
Success, Responsibility and Respect.

Youth Education Centre (YEC) is a school that operates over two sites. These sites are:

- Goldsborough Road Campus– this is within the Adelaide Youth Training Centre and caters for young male offenders aged 10 – 18 and young female offenders aged 10-18 or more years and who are serving detention orders or are on remand under the direction of the Adelaide Youth Court. A maximum of 48 students attend the school daily with a focus on the Australian Curriculum and SACE. Our Goldsborough Road site is open 49 weeks of the year with an alternative education program provided during term breaks.
- Flexicentre - is an alternative education campus located in the community and provides educational and vocational programs for young people between the ages of 14 – 18 years of age. Students at risk and/or have had experience with the Youth Justice system are given priority along with students from other mainstream sites who benefit from the smaller class size and may need additional support. The Flexicentre site is a small supportive learning environment. We have a vision to educate students to be inspired to achieve, to respect others, to learn about the importance of community and Aboriginal culture and to be responsible citizens. The school has three core values of Respect, Responsibility and Success.

We believe that young people learn best when they feel valued, listened to and, most importantly when they feel cared for and safe.

Students can access:

- SACE Stage 1 and 2 courses
- Short courses such as Learners Permit courses, White Card and Barista.
- VET courses
